<u>Stavros Niarchos Foundation Undergraduate Exchange Scholarships</u> <u>at York University in Toronto, Canada</u>



These Scholarships are available to students who are enrolled in undergraduate programs at institutions in Greece with which York University has a formal relationship, allowing them to study on exchange at York for one (1) or two (2) semesters each. The Scholarships are available to students from various disciplines with a preference for students pursuing courses that fall under York's Faculty of Liberal Arts & Professional Studies. There is funding available to support four (4) exchange semesters per year; exchange students can apply for funding for up to two (2) exchange semesters each.

Students interested in an exchange at York must apply through their home institution and are encouraged to do so as possible for admission into September 2016 and/or January 2017 sessions at York. The list of York's partners in Greece and information for exchange students is available through the York International website -

http://yorkinternational.yorku.ca/comingtoyorkuonexchange/. Students from institutions in Greece that are not listed as current partners are still encouraged to have their institution contact York International.
 Please Note: deadlines listed on the York International website are flexible – applications can be received after the deadline.

Application Process

- 1. Contact **Home Institution** Interested students are to first apply to their home institution for an international exchange at York. The home institution will review the application, and if approved, will nominate the student for an exchange at York.
- 2. Submit Exchange Application and SNF Scholarship Application Students nominated by their home institution must then complete the required exchange application form for undergraduate studies and the SNF Scholarship Application. Contact York International for on line access. Scholarship selection will be done by York International after reviewing the exchange and scholarship applications.
- 3. Review Areas of Study tab on website -http://yorkinternational.yorku.ca/comingtoyorkuonexchange/ for restricted programs.
- 4. Receive Admissions Package and Make Arrangements for Study Permits/Visas Approved applicants will be sent an admission package, which includes appropriate immigration documentation.
- 5. Enroll in **Courses** Students will be sent directions on how to enroll in courses. Review course listings through this website https://w2prod.sis.yorku.ca/Apps/WebObjects/cdm
