Strengths	Weaknesses
International visibility of the School	Unclear strategy for academic development
Tradition of innovation	Laboratory infrastructure inadequate
Multidsciplinarity	Limited offer of specialized topics and themes
High level academic staff	Very serious lack of adequate space
Sufficient thematic coverage	Undergraduate academic program problematic
Accessible administrative procedures	Limited communication and exchange between the two main modules
A network of international relations and cooperations	Limited cooperation between academic staff
A network of relations and cooperations with State institutions	Administrative difficulties
Practical experience offered to students	Unemployment of graduates
Laboratory experience to some degree	Negative ratio of students to academic staff and to infrastructures
Opportunities	Threats
Re-design the UG program of studies	Dramatic collapse of financing
Further advancement of cooperation with international and national institutions	Continuous decrease in staff
Increased participation in international research programs	Foundation of competitive programs in other Schools of Greece
Foundation of postgraduate studies in a foreign language to attract students from neighboring countries	Presence of other European institutions in Balkan countries
Funding through major programs (NPRD, Horizon 2020, etc)	Devaluation of infrastructures
Administrative optimization with the completion of IT platform	Serious economic and social devaluation of the status of university professors
Monitoring quality through the QA indexes	Absence of a stable national body for funding research
