- Established in 1926
- 1998-2000 Retrospective cataloging
- 2007-2013 Retrospective classification (replacing the old classification system with the classification system LC (Library of Congress)
- One of the 51 regional libraries library system AUTH
- The largest library of its kind in Northern Greece.







Annual borrowing statistics





Library of Archaeology and History of Art Difficulties

- Dramatic reduction of the regular budget
- Dramatic staff reduction due to internal displacements
- Limitation of the journals' subscriptions
- Upgrade of electronic equipment (PCs, scanners)
- Library expansion
- Heal-link electronical subscriptions' limitation
- Absence of a book conservation laboratory

Electronic Journals collection

- HEAL-Link (http://www.heal-link.gr/journals/) Through HEAL-Link Portal the members of the consortium have full-text access to electronic journals and books and to bibliographic databases.
- SWETSWISE Access to electronic journals of AUTH and all the electronic journals HEAL Link (current print and online subscriptions)
- JSTOR (Digital archive collection of core scholarly journals, mostly in the humanity and social sciences. The AUTh Library System provides full text access (~400 journal titles)
- PAO (Periodical Archive Online) is an online periodical archive that makes the backfiles of periodicals in the humanity and social sciences available electronically, providing access to the full text of a growing number of digitized periodicals.
- ProQuest Central is an online serial databases which provides access to nearly 12.500 journals with over 9.700 available in full text)






School of History and Archaeology - 107 lessons Total AUTH Departments : 42 - Number of lessons : 2.084
