






Number of subjects taught





Workload: ECTS Units



The structure of the program








- 10 (out of 21) Courses are offered by other Schools of the Faculty of Philosophy
- First three semesters are only open to Introductory courses

Results:


- The seats offered to our students are not enough
- Differences in the ECTS crediting system
- Prolongation of studies



 Obligatory seminars (2 for Archaeology and 3 for History) with an audience of 20 max, create a "bottleneck"

Result:

Prolongation of studies



- Students are allowed only two courses per subject
- There is a restriction of the courses students can follow from other Schools and Departments

Result:

Undergraduates cannot specialize in any subject
